An Unbelievable Prototype!

This automobile was a successful effort by Ford Motor Company to introduce a six-cylinder engine into a lightweight car. Detroit newspapers reported that Henry Ford drove this car around town showing off its incredible horsepower. Now fully restored, the car has been on a worldwide journey. It was purchased from the archives of The Henry Ford Museum in the late 1980s, sold to an owner in Australia and then purchased by the current owner in Ontario, Canada.
